Chair Pierquet reported that the County is looking in to establishing a short term rental ordinance and he has been discussing it with them. He will be meeting with Atty. Parmentier to further develop a Town ordinance.

At the suggestion of Town Atty. Parmentier, the Board approved updating the current Sex Offender Ordinance.

The Board considered a Certified Survey on Mountain Road submitted by Tom and Mike Lloyd. They currently jointly own the property and want to split it so each will own their own parcel. No zoning changes are necessary. Supervisor Kolell moved to approve the survey. Supervisor Julka seconded and the motion carried with all voting aye.

The Clerk reported that the web site update is still ongoing. Waiting on additional information from Bertram.

It was reported that Creek & Artesian Roads have visibility problems due to overgrown brush.

Bills were approved and paid.
